- How fast can you complete the trim trail?
- There are 4 carved wooden posts on the trail can you find them all? What animals are carved into them?
- Sometimes you will see lots of movement and hear lots of activity see if there are canoeists on the river or cyclists on the pump track.
- Tree bark has lots of different textures which is your favourite?
- Can you see any animals they may be on the river or in the trees.
- There are 3 pieces of street art around the loop can you find them?
- Can you see ripples on the river? What do you think caused them?
- Stand under a big tree and look up what patterns can you see?



- Can you hear birds singing in the trees?
- Can you hear the wind rushing through the branches or rain falling on the leaves?
- You'll find lots of flowers and leaves on the trail look out for different shapes, colours, textures, patterns and scents.
